CURRICULUM

Our main aims over the next coming weeks are:

English

Our focus for month of November will be story in familiar setting where our main focus will be non – fiction stories. Children will be able to explore unit on signs, labels and instructions. They will read and discuss a variety of instruction texts, first enjoying the texts as readers, then by giving instructions orally and then in writing.

They will use vocabulary such as a book, cover, beginning, end, page, line, word, letter and sentence.

Children will also do instruction writing. They will read and follow simple instructions, e.g. how to make a sandwich.

Grammar & Reading:

- As a part of Jolly Phonics, children will be recognizing letters and knowing which sounds they represent, through the Phonics games and different activities.
- They will be reading, writing and using 100 high frequently words in short sentences
- They will be able to hear, read and write all 3 sounds in single syllable words (eg. each sound is represent by two letters, so they are still one phoneme, so so a word like shop is a single syllable word
- To recognize different kinds of instructions (e.g. Go for a walk around the school, looking for labels which tell students what to do)
- To know how to predict the contents of a book (e.g. The children will use title, front cover picture and blurb to make predictions what's the book about



- Read and respond to question words, e.g. what, where, when, who, why
- They will be learning about nouns, adjectives and verbs and how to use it in a sentences.
- To recognize common words endings, e.g. s, ed, ing

Math:

In Maths this month, we will be looking at addition and subtraction, number bonds, patterns and symmetry and length.

Some of our primary focus for this month would be to:

- To understand addition as counting on and combining two sets
- To understand subtraction as counting back and take away
- To understand difference as “how many more to make”
- To recognize basic line symmetry
- To use comparative language e.g. longer, shorter, heavier, lighter
- To compare the lengths

Science

In Science, this month we will be learning about “Being alive”.

- Children will be learning about animals and plants and their local environments,
- Animal and human babies – how they grow and change,
- Things that are alive and things that have never been alive.

Humanities

In Humanities we will continue to learn about 7 continents and seas.

- Our focus will be North and South America, Europe, Australia and Antarctica as a continents, their countries and Ocean and seas in their surroundings.
- The children will be using a globe to locating continents, oceans, seas and counties on the map

French:

Unité 1 : Bienvenue!

Computing

Unit 1.2 - We are TV chefs Filming the steps of a recipe

- Break down a process into simple, clear steps, as in an algorithm.
- Use different features of a video camera.
- Use a video camera to capture moving images.
- Develop collaboration skills.
- Discuss their work and think about how it could be improved.

Swimming:

Children will be learning:

- to enter the pool safely, steps, ramp, swivel, walking
- front and back floats with support and return to a standing position
- to jump up and down in the water, open eyes, breathe from mouth and nose
- to move 3metres in the water by walking, jumping, hopping or holding side.
- exit the pool safely and unassisted.

PE:

- Children will be learning how to explore different shapes to consolidate and improve the quantity of their actions, body shapes and balances
- to create sequences on mats, using good quality, traveling actions, body shapes and balances

Art

Our main aims over the next few weeks:

- Children will be learning how to become more familiar with pattern, introduce pentangle design
- use what the students know about different designs to create a name art piece using design
- Children will be using different shapes to make different designs

Qatar History

- Children will be learning about Qatar, where is located, about the Arabian Gulf and the names of Gulf countries. They will be learning about Peninsula and Qatar's border.
