In this month the students will be busy learning concepts from different subjects. The learning objectives for the subjects are mentioned below.

Please check your Class Dojo, regularly as this will be our main form of communication. We have also planned Qatar National celebrations in a grand way!

CURRICULUM

Our main aims over the next coming weeks are:

English:

Grammar & Reading:

We are reading story extracts and discover how words make a story interesting and to write some descriptions;

We will learn

*to use capital letters at the beginning of proper nouns;

*to use apostrophe (') with the letter to show possession;

*to use speech marks to show that someone is talking;

Math:

In Math this month, we will practicing Counting in 8. Children would solve word problems and reason them mathematically.

Some of our primary focus for this month would be

* to count in multiples of 8;

* to recall the multiplication and division facts for the 8 multiplication table;

* to use doubling to recall the 8 multiplication tables;

* to multiply a tens number by 8;

* to solve word problems and reason mathematically;

Science:

In science our focus will be to learn about water plants, desert plants and mountain plants.

We will learn to

- *to know that plants are adapted to suit their environment;
- *to name and draw some desert plants, water plants and mountain plants;
- *to name some special adaptations of plants;
- *to know that plant growth is affected by temperature;

Humanities:

- * to know details about the history of flights
- * to understand the role of flights in our life
- * to name some famous pilots throughout aviation history

PE:

Children will be learning;

- *to introduce the "dribble" as a way of travelling with the ball.
- *to introduce the "jump stop" as a way of stopping

Art:

- * to differentiate between abstract art and realistic art pieces of work
- * to draw their own abstract art work
- * to attempt to interpret other abstract pieces of work
- * to give details about the artist Raouda Choucair

French:

Year 3 Unité 1 :

- * **Demander et indiquer le chemin (ask and indicate the way)**
- * **Le verbe aller (the verb "to go").**

ICT:

Unit 2 :- We are bug fixers Finding and correcting bugs in programs.

- Develop a number of strategies for finding errors in programs.
- Build up resilience and strategies for problem solving.
- Increase their knowledge and understanding of Scratch.
- Recognize a number of common types of bug in software.

Unit 3.3 :- We are presenters Videoing performance

- Gain skills in shooting live video, such as framing shots, holding the camera steady, and reviewing.
- Edit video, including adding narration and editing clips by setting in/out points.
- Understand the qualities of effective video, such as the importance of narrative, consistency, perspective and scene length.
